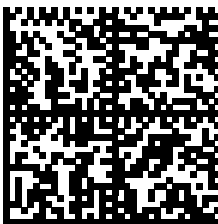

Haga e paralajmëroi që në vitin 2020 dënimin e ish-krerëve të UCK-së

Një dokument që hedh dritë mbi një takim të zhvilluar më 7 dhe 8 dhjetor 2020 në Hagë ka rikthyer debatet mbi procesin gjyqësor ndaj ish-krerëve të UÇK-së, Hashim Thaçi, Kadri Veseli, Jakup Krasniqi dhe Rexhep Selimi. Sipas dokumentit të bërë publik, në takimin me diplomatët të akredituar në Kosovë morën pjesë kryetarja e Dhomave të Specializuara, Ekaterina Trendafilova, ish-kryeprokurori i Specializuar Jack Smith dhe regjistruesja Fidelma Donlon. Sipas materialit, Smith deklaroi se besonte se të akuzuarit do të përballeshin me dënime shumë të rënda, ndërsa kërkoi mbështetje për punën e Prokurorisë.

Në dokument përmenden edhe deklaratat e Trendafilovës lidhur me krijimin dhe funksionimin e Dhomave të Specializuara, ndërsa ajo shpjegoi se institucioni ishte krijuar për trajtimin e përgjegjësjve individuale dhe mbrojtjen e dëshmitarëve. Gjatë takimit, ambasadori gjerman ngriti edhe çështjen e mungesës së flamurit dhe simboleve shtetërore të Kosovës në sallën e gjyqit. Trendafilova e cilësoi këtë çështje si një debat politik që, sipas saj, synonte delegjitimimin e institucionit. Regjistruesja Fidelma Donlon, nga ana tjetër, deklaroi se Dhomat zbatonin standartet ndërkombëtare për mbrojtjen e dëshmitarëve dhe të drejtat e të akuzuarve.

Më 16 shtator 2026, Dhomat e Specializuara në Hagë shpallën fajtorë Thačin, Veselin, Krasniqin dhe Selimin për disa vepra penale të lidhura me arrestimin dhe ndalimin e paligjshëm ose arbitrar, trajtimin mizor, torturën dhe vrasjen. Thaçi dhe Krasniqi u dënuan me nga 25 vite burg, Veseli me 18 vite dhe Selimi me 13 vite, gjithsej 81 vite burgim. Vendimi është i shkallës së parë dhe mund të ankimohet. Pretendimi se rezultati i procesit ishte paracaktuar që në vitin 2020 mbetet një interpretim i lidhur me dokumentin dhe deklaratat e përmendura, dhe nuk është i njëjtë me një konstatim gjyqësor se vendimi ishte paracaktuar.

	end of the arrest conflict, for these reasons, the ICTY case did not in a position to fully address all crimes assessed in the report, although it adjudicated two cases which relate to the general context. She explained more about why the court was established, the history and the establishment of the procedures and systems. Then she commented on some more specific issues related to the cases and processes related to operations. She said that currently the Specialist Chambers are handling three cases: Sali Mustafa, Gashi and Hoxhendi. These are in trials, arrests and hearings. She said Mustafa case did not begin really in the last quarter of 2011, more for hearings and Gashi the indictment is in process for contribution or device and hearing such a hearing there it is more case than it proceed further. On Thaci case she said that it was a complicated case with a very large material and due to this it is unclear when the trial will begin, while at the same time the lawyers compose a large team that also complicates the work of the Specialist Chambers. She said the Specialist Chambers to be able to fulfil their mandates and succeed in addressing all crimes and a strong general support from all of them. She was happy that the latest appointments have been made and the Specialist Chambers have now 36 judges from different countries and that there is a strong institutional spirit to ensure rule of law and administration of justice for the people of Kosovo. The Current Ambassador asked her who the flag and symbols of Kosovo are not shown in the Court to get the answer of Thaci said: "International said that the Specialist Chambers are a complex institution that brings together professionals from many countries and therefore it is not for one or two countries. She said the leaders of Thaci himself and president of the court coming to a state general assembly that would designate the Specialist Chambers, but the pro-Thaci party has tried not to participate in them, while still not in the case of Thaci's conviction. It is a state after Thaci's trial in a court and the whole institution to shape the Specialist Chambers as something foreign to the people of Kosovo." Asked if the Court will be allowed to hold proceedings outside The Hague, she said the question was addressed in the Exchange of Letters and later reflected in the Law on Specialist Chambers and Specialist Prosecutor's Office, which provides that the seat of the ICC may be equally in Kosovo and in The Hague. The decision to hold proceedings in the territory where the alleged crimes were committed, however, requires consensus of the members of the court, members of countries and states involved in the proceedings. For these reasons, it also depends on every party that is sitting at different stages of the proceedings, but it is Basic Court, Court of Appeals, Supreme Court and Constitutional Court. Proceedings in situ may not only encourage, but also have peaceful reconciliation in post-conflict societies. She said that there is an orchestrated smear campaign against the Specialist Chambers, including such flag court, ICT dispute with KLA and linking the Specialist Chambers to Serbia. She said ICT is a international criminal court but has nothing to do with KLA, that the Specialist Chambers are not dealing with the KLA as an organization but individual crimes committed in Kosovo against victims of all ethnicities. She said the Specialist Chambers are applying the highest international criminal law standards.	
	She said referring to the case of Thaci that she has been informed by Specialist Prosecutor Jack Smith that he will present the reasons why Thaci should not be released on bail and that the independent judge will take a decision on the matter. She said that such a decision will be based on the ICC Law and the contribution of Kosovo that includes also the European and international conventions, although Kosovo is not a member of the Council of Europe. Also presenting an interesting and complex legal framework in coordination for this case. Specialist Prosecutor Jack Smith: Jack Smith was very tough and direct in his presentation. He said his job is to show to the people of Kosovo that the individuals charged by ICC have committed war crimes and crimes against humanity against all people of Kosovo of all ethnic and political backgrounds and that the Specialist Chambers will serve justice to the victims in Kosovo. He said that he has been confronted from his first days with attempts to obstruct the Specialist Chambers and Prosecutor's Office and their work, mainly by Thaci, vetoes and pressure to stop in Kosovo's government and society. This is the reason why he was forced to come to make a statement to show to the people of Kosovo and the international community that he and his colleagues are not self-interested efforts by Thaci to hinder the work and administration of justice. Asked when did Thaci do, he said he was very clear in his statement and to threaten EU and other countries for making statements that threatened the observations by Thaci. He said the public support given to the Specialist Chambers by Ambassadors in Kosovo has helped the court, because ambassadors are calling to the Specialist Chambers making the commitment the international community towards the Specialist Chambers. Now witnesses who were under immense pressure by Thaci and his loyal people are being confident more in the work and ability of Specialist Chambers to serve justice to the victims. He said according to his statement submitted against Thaci, which is supported on many points for releasing and conviction. Thaci, vetoes and vetoes will get into rules sentence by the court for the entire stay, have convicted. He said his independent chair functions of victims' interests, interests, determined under the direction of the ICC, he said that to victims of ICT in Thaci and other individuals charged, and not the KLA, but people loyal to Thaci are conducting a campaign to dealing with this legal working, and he urged Ambassadors to be clear to the public and support the Prosecutor's Office by countering the smear campaign by people loyal to Thaci. He said he is very grateful to EULEX Mission for the support provided to SPO and to the Kosovo Police that has been part of the operation that has supported the SPO in all operations, especially as the communication has improved with the Kosovo Police in recent months. He said that Gashi and Hoxhendi have been part of an continuous operation to intimidate the witnesses and that he is concerned both Gashi and Hoxhendi acted in coordination with Thaci and loyal and he is investigating if any link can be proved, although he said environment in Kosovo is difficult to conduct the investigations.	
	He said he is grateful to the professional journalists in Kosovo who have not become part of this well-organized and orchestrated operations to publish classified documents by the Specialist Chambers. He said the strategy of the lawyers of Thaci is to delay the trial and get bail based on this, and also threats of Thaci and harm the criminal as witnesses will be intimidated and threatened by him and his loyal people, for damaging the process and threatening the witnesses. He said that the list of witnesses will be kept secret. He asked for countries to agree to extradition agreements with the Specialist Chambers, he said that have already come, but more are needed. He said 17 extradition requests have been made and urged the Ambassadors to pressure their capitals to react faster to this. He said that there also need more personnel in the SPO and urged countries to second more officers, prosecutors, investigators so that the institution can serve justice to the people of Kosovo. He thanked Switzerland for providing financial and technical support for the outreach programme in Kosovo. Registrar of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers Dr Fátima Denton: The Registrar of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers is the highest administrative authority within the court, as well as the chair of judicial support services, ensuring that of evidence, legal and operational support is provided to the Chambers and Specialist Prosecutor's Office. Dr Denton explained that, with her appointment of Registrar of the Registry of the Specialist Chambers in April 2016, the institution of the Specialist Chambers formally came into existence. It is an honour and privilege to serve as Registrar of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers. A well-functioning Registry is one of the crucial components of an efficient court. I am delighted to confirm the Chamber's mission and functioning across, independent, impartial, fair and ethical criminal proceedings before the Chambers, she stated. The Registrar of the Specialist Chambers is responsible for the administration and delivery of the Specialist Chambers and all necessary and affiliated functions. It is to its nature independent and impartial, providing services to all organs and participants in the proceedings. It includes, among others, a Victims Protection and Support Office, a Defence Office, a Victims Participation Office, a Court Management Office, a Detention Unit, an Ombudsman's Office and other various administrative and judicial support units. She said the Law creates the framework for a robust witness protection measures, with her request for the signs of the victims, she stated to strengthen the highest standards of protection for individuals who may be at risk on account of their participation in the justice process. This is something we take very seriously. The Registry is also a key actor in safeguarding the rights of any suspect or accused. Its Defence Office will ensure a fair of accused rights to proceed before the Specialist Chambers as well as a system for representation of indigent accused. The rights of the accused provided for are consistent with the standards set by the European Court of Human Rights.	
	The Specialist Chambers provide for the participation in judicial proceedings of victims who have suffered harm as a direct result of a crime within their jurisdiction. Its Victims Participation Office will commence managing the application process for victims to participate in the proceedings and providing advice to such victims. She provided also a briefing on the arrest and transfer of all suspects from Kosovo to The Hague.
